





Intent - Applications

- The one place for schools to make all grant applications
- Provides a methodical approach for the completion of applications
- Work in a paperless mode, as often as possible



Intent - Grant Administration

- The one place to view historical project records
- Easy access to and submission of documents at each stage of the grant process
- No more e-mails with grant documents as attachments- hooray!

- Need to register as a Client Portal User:

 - Agree to the Privacy considerations

Users will

 Enter into the Terms and Conditions as an agent of the Approved Authority which you represent

Users are

 Indicating an agreement to be bound by the Terms and Conditions by proceeding to use the Enquire solution

Client Portal Roles-Assigned Permissions

Key Contact

- Receives ALL notifications sent by QIS BGA
- One key contact per organisation system constrained

Account Administrator

 Invites, removes and manages the currency of contacts in a school's business account

Standard User

- View, update, submit applications and grant administration documentation
- View data and document records across all areas of the school's business account

Accountable Officer

 Holds overall accountability for the school's participation with QIS BGA as an agent of the Approved Authority

Client Portal Roles - Operational Arrangements

- Approved Authorities and their schools are responsible for determining the roles to be assigned to users.
- Consider:
 - Who should be able to view application materials and grant records?
 - Who will work on an application in the Portal?
 - Who can view and authorise an application?
 - Who will submit an application?
 - Who should receive QIS BGA task notifications?
 - Who will submit the required grant administration documents?
 - Are you a user responsible for more than one school?

Application, Assessment & Administration

Application requirements and content remains the same

- EIS/Master Plan: detailed online capture of all application data via the Client Portal
- Capital Grants: existing application spreadsheet with access/submission via the Client Portal


Assessment process remains the same

- EIS/Master Plan: same assessment process
- Capital Grants: same assessment process and school visits


New grant administration procedures BUT requirements remain the same.





Stages of Grant Administration


