AUDIT CHECKLIST - COOL

- □ Consider window coverings (blinds/curtains) throughout.
- □ Consider opportunities to better seal your buildings.
- □ Consider options for temporary or permanent shading.
- □ Consider options for natural or mechanical ventilation.
- □ Consider light-coloured materials options for roofs and facades.
- Consider opportunities to increase trees and planting.

AUDIT CHECKLIST - HEALTHY

- □ Procure only low-VOC paints, sealants and carpets.
- □ Provide indoor plants to improve air quality and aesthetics.
- □ Procure healthy fitout items (Global GreenTag rated).
- □ Consider opportunities to improve ventilation and airflow.
- □ Provide healthy tuckshop food and consider food growing.
- □ Run wellness and mindfulness programs.
- Consider opportunities to improve natural light during the day.
- □ Consider opportunities to engage positively with the community.
